## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MUNCIE AMENDING THE CITY OF MUNCIE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT ARP FUND PLAN

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2021, the Common Council of the City of Muncie adopted Ordinance 16-21 approving the City of Muncie American Rescue Plan Act ARP Fund Plan ("ARP Fund Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the ARP Fund Plan is the City of Muncie's plan for the use and distribution of grant funds provided to the City of Muncie through the federal government's adoption of Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARP Funds"); and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. 16-21 provides that the ARP Fund Plan may be amended only by ordinance or resolution of the Common Council of the City of Muncie; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Muncie desires to make certain amendments to the ARP Fund Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNCIE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The 2022-2024 Allocation of ARP Funds shall be amended to reduce the amount of ARP Funds allocated to the City of Muncie 2022 Budget Shortfall from \$1,924,430.00 to \$1,424,43000, and the classification title for these funds shall be amended to City of Muncie 2022 Revenue Loss/Provision of Government Services to reflect changes to the United States Department of the Treasury's Final Rule for the use of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds in the ARP ("Final Rule"). As set forth in the Final Rule, these funds shall be used for the provision of general government services.

Section 2: The 2022-2024 Allocation of ARP Funds shall be further amended to allocate \$500,000.00 to the Whitely Community Council to be used in the development and construction of the Centennial Building Project. The Centennial Building Project will serve a disproportionately impacted area of the community by providing workforce development, housing services, financial resources, education, small business training and support, access to affordable food, access to affordable health care services and other resources to improve the quality of life in the Whitely community.

<u>Section 3</u>: The classification title of City of Muncie 2023 Budget Shortfall shall be amended to City of Muncie 2022 Revenue Loss/Provision of Government Services, and the funds allocated under that classification shall be used for the provision of general government services.

**Section 4:** The Summary of Funding Allocation for 2022-2024 shall be amended to read as follows:
