- 3. Roll Call Members Present: Linda Gregory Lola Mauer Ted Baker
- 4. Approval of the Minutes for the November 24, 2021: President Gregory entertained a motion to approve. Lola Mauer moved to approve minutes from the November 24, 2021 meeting as printed. Ted Baker provided second. Motion passed by voice vote.
- Register of Claims: Craig Wright, City Controller commented there is a few claims I would like to bring to your attention. Page #9 \$22,879.11 Superfleet Mastercard police monthly fuel charge. Page #10 \$18,564.10 Tom Leaird's Underwater Service police dry-suits and dive team equipment. Page #10 \$127,780 Non-Profit Organizations Five (5) ARP checks. Page #15 \$15,677.56 Star Financial Bank police lease vehicles payment. Page #16 \$37,886.39 Humana Insurance fire pension Medicare Supplement. Linda Gregory asked Craig Wright for a little bit more information on the payment to Indiana Title, such as where is the funds coming from. Craig reported it came out of the EDIT Funds they are turning the bottom floor and top floor into parking which is much needed for Downtown and remaining floor will be converted into Apartments. 8. Accept and Award Demolition Contract for 1800 S. Burlington Dr. (Former Marsh Supermarket & Family Dollar): Zane Bishop, Community Development Planner before the Board today is City of Muncie Community Development Block Grant Program Year 2021 1800 S. Burlington ET. Al., Clearance Contract for Services. With Renascent, Inc., 938 w. Troy Avenue, Indianapolis, IN and TWG Development, LLC 1301 E. Washington Street, Suite 100, Indianapolis, Indiana. Renascent was the low bidder factoring in the alternatives that the developer wanted to accept at \$164,000. The City will be paying \$123,692. Which is the budgeted amount for the year 2021 and the developer will be picking up the remaining cost of \$40,308.

Base Bid (demo. Abate CMC Joint compound \$178,000.
Remove Asphalt Alt. #1 39,500.
Minus Alt. #2 keeping asphalt millings - 18,500.
Minus Alt. #3 keeping recyclable concrete on site - 35,000.

The contractor will grind up the millings and concrete and reuse them on the site and construction should begin once the parking lot millings are removed. President Gregory entertained a motion. Lola Mauer moved to accept bid from Renascent, Inc. and enter into Contract as presented. Ted Baker provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

- 9. Proposal for Assessment and Development of Scope of Work for Rehabilitation work on the McCulloch Park Lodge from Jonathan C. Spodek: Brad King reported that Jonathan Spodek would visit the site to inspect the property, document existing conditions, capture digital photographs of the subject building and site to be utilized during the remaining phases of the project. Meet with City and/or Park District staff to discuss findings, priorities and scope of work, for \$7,000. President Gregory entertained a motion. Ted Baker moved to accept Proposal from Jonathan C. Spodek for Assessment and Development of Scope of Work for Rehabilitation work on the McCulloch Park Lodge #6. Lola Mauer provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
- Brian Stephens-Hotopp came forward to give an update on a recent grant award; in 2021, we had submitted a grant application for community crossings and were awarded \$699,916.81 we also submitted for the second time for the second round, as a community we are eligible to submit up to One Million Dollars in grant requests. We were recently awarded \$300,083.19 this is going towards multiple sections of Mulberry Street on the south side. INDOT is moving forward on a docu-sign procedure for other contracts. Therefore, we are in process of preparing a Resolution for the Board. Too essentially empower the Mayor as the kind signatory for the docu-sign documents with INDOT moving forward. That should be coming before you in the next week or so. Lastly, this is my last Board of Works meeting, I wanted to appreciate all the work that you all have done, I really enjoyed with working you all, and I introduced Adam Leach who is our new City Engineer. I wish you all well and it has been an honor working with you so thanks. President Gregory commented that she appreciated all that you have done it is easy to come to these meetings and know all the documentation is in place and if we have questions, there is immediate responses. You have set a high bar. Best wishes on your next venture.
